

Naomi is in her junior year of college and will finish a semester early next year with a bachelor's in English. She intends to then start a masters program in education that will include a teaching credential. This will be at the same school Jonathan is at when he will be starting second semester of sophomore year. Kathy and I are looking forward to see how this plays out:)

Jonathan just started second semester of freshmen year after getting all A's first semester. He is doing well and sets meticulous plans for himself to get homework done early. He enjoys his friends group and chapels, and wants to grow in Christ.

Brandon is nearing the end of radiation treatments for a grade 4 brain tumor that was removed October 3rd. We have raised money through gofundme to pay for extra care for him that has paid off.
